LATIN AMERICAN COMMITTEE FOR SELECTION OF PAPERS (CLS) AND REQUIREMENTS FOR PRESENTATIONS

Objective

To promote systematization and conceptualization of Latin American coaches work experience, motivating them to offer their expertise in a professional and impeccable way.

Schedule

January 30th: Call for Papers.

March 15th : Deadline for response to call for papers.

April 15th : Notification of approval to authors by Committee and sending of formats to be filled by authors to apply for ICF Continuing Coaching Education Units.

April 20th: Deadline for reception of CCEUs filled formats.

April 30th : Ending of functions of the Latin American Committee for Selection of Papers (CLS).

Working Procedure

Once the Committee is constituted, its members will determine the starting date of their work and will by consensus establish working procedure and criteria for approval of papers.

Papers should be sent to the following electronic address: conferencialatina2010@icfperu.org
Once they are received, they will be forwarded to each member of the Committee (CLS) for reading, analysis and commentaries.

Each member of CLS will issue his commentaries with copy to all other members, taking into consideration the following criteria:

Theme and Contents:

Clear Conceptualization.

Focus on one of the proposed thematic axes.

Tools, proposals, or innovative subjects.

Relevance of subject for Latin America.

Design:

Clarity of presentation.

Apropriativeness of methodology.

Requeriments for prospective authors.

Resume (half page) containing formation and experience in the field of coaching.

The subject or case must be presented with rigurocity, impeccability, clarity and simplicity, considering:

- Title
- Subject
- Objective
- Main Concepts
- Toolds
- Methodology to be applied
- Summary of the content in three pages, at the most.
- The selected authors will have to fill the appropriate form in order to request ICF Continuum Coaching Education Units and start necessary coordinations to facilitate their presentations.

- Presentation should have the workshop format, making emphasis on the use of tools. Documents must be written in Word using Arial 12 font, double spaced, in a maximum extension of three pages.

Deadline for receiving papers will be March 15.

Final indications for authors

After Committee's approval, authors will be notified that they have been selected as presenters, no later than April 15th.

Upon approval, authors will receive the form to apply for Continuing Coaching Education Units (credits that are assigned to papers according to ICF regulations and used for accreditation of coaches)

Deadline for sending the completed form for CCEU's will be April 20th.
