

If you are currently:

A Non-Credentialed Member—Beginning April 1, 2012, current members who **have not completed** at least 60 hours of coach-specific training* will be considered **Provisional Members** for a **maximum** of one year (until April 1, 2013) or until the minimum membership eligibility requirements are fulfilled, if completed before April 1, 2013. Of course, coach-specific training* hours accumulated between now and the official policy launch on April 1, 2013 will also be applicable.

The **Provisional Member category** will be **limited to one year** (April 1, 2012 to April 1, 2013), at which time the individual either qualifies to become an ICF Coach Member (or an ICF Credentialed Coach Member) or leaves the ICF until such time as they qualify.



****Definition of Training that is accepted as coach specific training:***

- Training from an Accredited Coach Training Program (ACTP) or a program that has received the ICF Approved Coach Specific Training Hours (ACSTH) designation.
- Training from a Continuing Coach Education (CCE) Provider, subject to these limitations:
 - All hours approved in Core Competencies will be accepted.
 - A maximum of 12 hours outside of the Core Competencies will be accepted.
- Training that is specifically marketed as teaching coaching skills, that teaches coaching skills or teaches how to apply technical skills in a coach-like manner and teaches coaching skills in accordance with the ICF Core Competencies.
